Board Meeting Minutes

Date: 4/8/25 Location: Zoom Facilitator: Malcolm / Robin Note-Taker: Malcolm

1. Welcome & Introductions

- Malcolm began with a grounding exercise
- Each board member introduced themselves and shared personal updates:
 - Zakee spoke about his reentry journey and new role
 - Marcel joined from vacation and shared website insights
 - Dave and Robin expressed excitement for the board's expansion and mission

2. Meeting Norms & Organizational Overview

- Norms agreed upon:
 - Start/end on time
 - *Remain fully present (no multitasking)*
 - Capture action items with assigned owners
 - Avoid crosstalk
- Malcolm presented the mission, vision, values, and program structure
- Highlighted impact: 25% recidivism vs. 42% state average
- Decision: Incorporate reentry prep (digital literacy, job readiness) into the work

3. Financial Overview

- Jennifer shared March budget vs. actual (under budget by \$1,175)
- Explained cash-flow timing tied to grant disbursement
- Strategy: Keep minimal checking balance—move excess to interest-bearing accounts
- Jay noted ~18 months of current funding; grant writer engagement planned

4. Legal Duties of Board Members

- Robin led an overview of legal responsibilities:
 - Duty of Care informed, attentive in decision-making
 - Duty of Loyalty act in the organization's best interest
 - Duty of Obedience follow bylaws and mission alignment
- Reviewed the 10 core nonprofit board responsibilities
- Agreed to review and update bylaws after the retreat

5. Communication Platforms

- Decided on Signal for general communication
- Use Slack for more in-depth discussions
- Google Drive to serve as the shared repository for board docs

6. Program Progress

- Jay updated on curriculum and graduation prep at CSP Sacramento
- Malcolm shared participant feedback and emotional responses
- Zakee proposed documenting graduations via photo/video
- Dave reiterated his appreciation for program impact

7. Strategic Planning Retreat

- Scheduled: May 3–4—focused on setting a 3–5 year strategic direction
- Robin shared retreat agenda: feedback review \rightarrow visioning \rightarrow action roadmap
- Dave requested prep materials (TED Talk, Simon Sinek video) to be shared
- Action: Board members to review curriculum in advance (video + digital)
